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Template OV1: Overview of RWA

The table below provides an overview of RWA and the related minimum capital requirements by risk type. For the purpose of risk management and regulatory consolidation, the Group refers to the consolidation of Public Bank (Hong Kong) Limited (the "Bank") and Public Finance Limited ("Public Finance"). The Group has adopted standardised approach for both credit risk and market risk. Regarding operational risk, the Bank and Public Finance have adopted basic indicator approach and standardised approach respectively. During the first quarter of 2023, RWA increased by HK\$220.38 million to HK\$25.29 billion, mainly due to increase in credit risk for non-securitisation exposures related to amounts receivable from security dealing business and placements with banks.
