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## **Template OV1: Overview of RWA**

The table below provides an overview of RWA and the related minimum capital requirements by risk type. The Company has adopted standardized approach for both credit risk and operational risk. During the first quarter of 2022, RWA decreased by HK\$149.6 million to HK\$4.89 billion. The decrease of RWA was mainly due to a decrease in credit risk for non-securitization exposures related to loans and advances.
